This month we are celebrating the virtue of **JUSTICE** – one of the building blocks in developing moral intelligence in young people. From a young age, students have a strong sense of what is fair. As they grow, they develop the capacity to decipher right from wrong and to make ethical decisions.

This theme of **Justice** ties in with the **Catholic Graduate Expectation** of a **Responsible Citizen** – one who gives witness to Catholic social teaching by promoting peace, justice and the sacredness of human life. Traditionally, our Catholic Schools have made outstanding contributions to society through Social Justice causes. Students in both our elementary and secondary schools have raised funds to support many causes both locally and abroad, including the Society of St. Vincent de Paul. We are very proud of the contributions our students have made and continue to make through their altruistic efforts.



- 1. Help your child understand the importance of fairness, which includes the very important idea that fairness doesn't always mean sameness.
- 2. Help your child see other people's points of view in a conflict
- 3. Model and encourage children to think before acting or speaking.


